Trustee David Gutierrez – Advised that he would like students to come to the Springer Satellite for one (1) day to see what can be done with the simulators. He further advised that we need to work together.

Ms. Carole Rutten, (guest in audience) of Los Alamos National Labs was addressed the Board and advised that LANL pledges to continue working with LCC. Ms. Rutten also advised that currently LANL is looking for plumbers, pipe fitters, general laborers and electricians.
